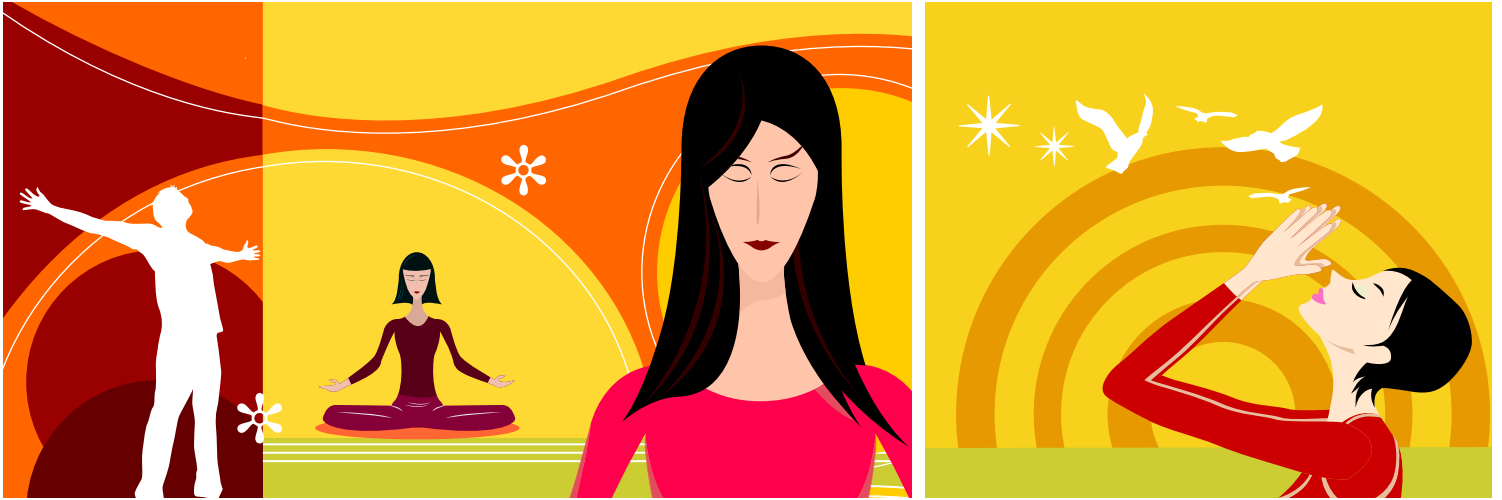

## Introduction

### **Dev Sankriti University**

## How to Reach

**By Air:** Domestic Air Line Services are available from main cities of India to Dehradun (Jolly Grant Air Port), which is 20 Km. North from Haridwar. From Dehradun to Haridwar trains and Buses are available frequently.

**By Train:** Direct trains are available from all the main cities of India to Haridwar. Delhi is connected by two Shatabdi & One Rajdhani Express train.

**By Bus:** Fast Bus services are available from all main cities of north India to Haridwar.

**By Taxi:** You can hire Taxi from Delhi to Haridwar. (Approximately Charges -2500-2800)

## Passport and Visa Requirements

The delegates are advised to contact the Indian Embassy/High Commission/Consulate in their country in order to obtain a visa of entry. Please apply for your visa in advance. Your travel agent may also be able to help you.

Foreign visitors entering India must have a passport valid for at least six months after their date of entry in India, except in the case of nationals of Bhutan and Nepal who need only carry suitable means of identification.

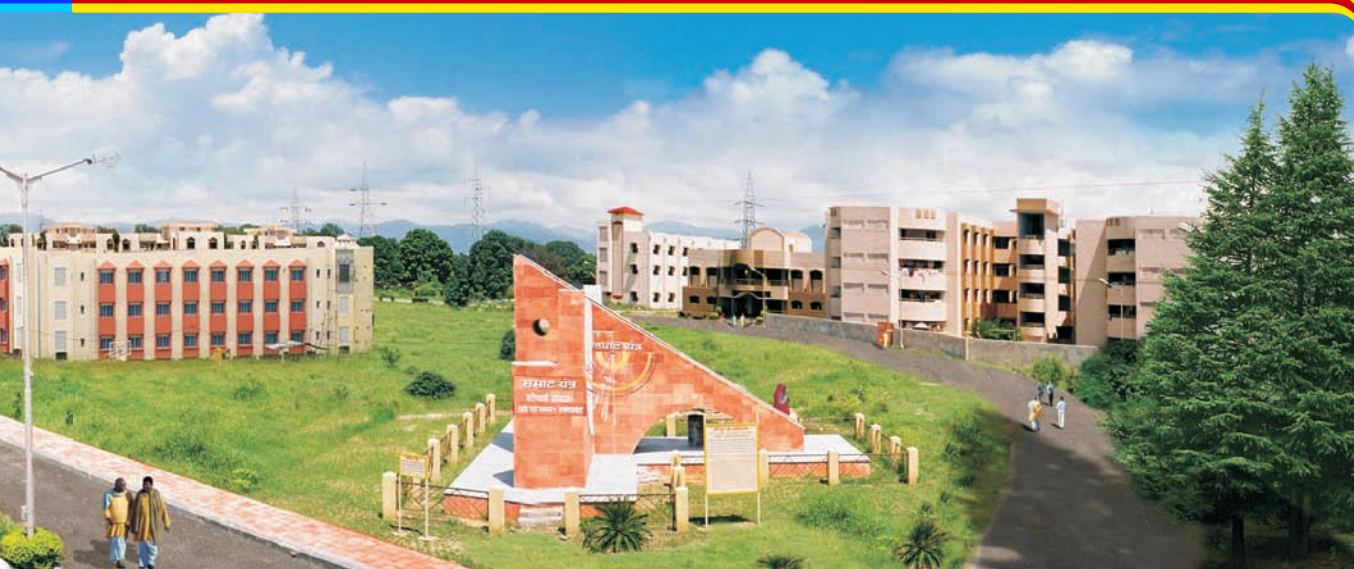
